



Chasing Georgia's Civil War History

For all you history buffs, this tour is for you! Beginning in Kennesaw, GA, formerly known as 'Big Shanty', we'll visit the Southern Museum of Civil War and Locomotive History. This is the site of the hijacking of the Confederate locomotive the General which is on display, restored to its original condition. In April of 1862, Union spies stole the General intent on wreaking havoc by cutting the supply lines to Chattanooga on the Western and Atlantic Railroad and we'll follow the route of The Great Locomotive Chase on our way northward. Union troops led by General Wm. Rosecrans stalled their advance a year and a half later against General Braxton Bragg's rebel soldiers near Lookout Mountain and we'll tour the battlefield at Chickamauga, the site of the Confederate's last major victory.

Riding along the tip of the Blue Ridge Mountains, our tour will follow Sherman's Atlanta Campaign and then the infamous March to the Sea through the rolling hills of Georgia's Piedmont on our way to Savannah. Along the way, the tour makes stops at major points of interest in these campaigns as we learn of the hardships and challenges faced on both sides of the conflict and of the residents in their path. Some of the small towns we visit have changed very little since reconstruction.
